










Location

1 stage will be held on one of the best speedway stadiums in Europe

In 2010 FIM assigned type "A" category to the stadium

Restaurant, hotel, parking, ice skating ring, gym, sauna, infrared cabin, trampolining hall – located at the stadium

The stadium capacity 15,000 spectators
Track length - 353 m
